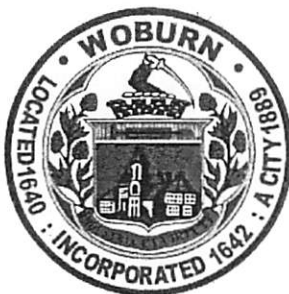

Dear Parent/Guardian,

As required by law (MGL c76,ss15 and 15c, 105 CMR 220.000), no child shall be admitted to school except upon presentation of a physician's certificate stating the child has been successfully immunized against Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus, Polio, Hepatitis B, Measles, Mumps, Rubella and Varicella. This certificate will be kept on file in your child's health record.

Immunizations required by Massachusetts State Law:

Required for entry into Kindergarten:

DTaP/DTP:	5 doses	MMR:	2 doses
Polio:	4 doses	Varicella:	2 doses
Hepatitis B:	3 doses	Lead screening	

As of 2011, the Massachusetts Department of Public Health requires physician certification of the following additional immunization for

Entry into 7th grade:

Tdap: 1dose MMR: 2 doses (total) Varicella: 2 doses (total)
