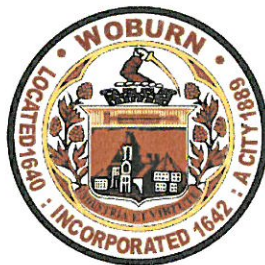


# Woburn Public Schools

Dear Parent or Guardian

Massachusetts General Law Chapter 71, Section 57 mandates periodic physical examinations of all school age children.

Physical examinations are required on all students entering kindergarten, grade 4, grade 7 and grade 10 to identify health conditions that may affect students' well-being and ability to learn. Additionally, all students enrolling in the Woburn Public Schools, regardless of their grade, must present a copy of a physical exam to the School Nurse. This exam may be performed within one year prior to entrance to school or within 30 days after school entry. Students participating in high school sports program must submit a current physical exam each year prior to participation in the sport.

The physical exam must be done by your health care provider and the completed form returned to the School Nurse. Please set up an appointment for your child with your health care provider as soon as possible.

Thank you for your cooperation with this Massachusetts Department of Public Health Regulation which will benefit the health and well-being of your child.
